## Plan of classes for 4<sup>th</sup> year students of medical faculty Infectious Diseases

- 1. General questions of infectious diseases. Fever of unknown origin. Salmonellosis of typhoid and nontyphoid groups (Typhoid fever. Paratyphoid A and B. Salmonellosis).
- 2. Bacterial intestinal infections (Shigellosis. Cholera. Escherichiosis. Yersiniosis. C.difficile-associated infection).
- 3. Foodborne toxicoinfection. Botulism. Viral intestinal infections. Protozoal intestinal infections (Amoebiasis). Pathogenetic types of infectious diarrhea.
- 4. Infectious diseases occurring with a predominant lesion of the central nervous system (Meningococcal infection. Rabies). The main clinical syndromes of damage to the central nervous system. Analysis and interpretation of CSF.
  - 5. Acute viral hepatitis (enteral and parenteral viral hepatitis).
- 6. Complications and outcomes of viral hepatitis (Acute and chronic liver failure. Virus-associated cirrhosis of the liver. Hepatocellular carcinoma). Leptospirosis. Brucellosis.
