

Plan of classes for 5th year students of medical faculty Infectious Diseases

1. Acute respiratory viral infections (Influenza. Parainfluenza. Adenovirus infection. RS viral infection. Rhinovirus infection. Coronavirus infection). Respiratory tract infections caused by intracellular pathogens (Respiratory chlamydial infection. Respiratory mycoplasmosis).
2. Vector-borne diseases (Rickettsioses. Epidemic typhus and Brill-Zinsser disease. Malaria. Tick-borne encephalitis. Lyme disease).
3. Emergent infections. Other zoonoses (Plague. Anthrax. Tularemia. Hemorrhagic viral fevers. Hemorrhagic fever with renal syndrome. Disease caused by the Ebola virus).
4. Sepsis. Infections of the outer skin. (Tetanus. Erysipelas).
5. HIV- infection.
6. Helminthic infections (Enterobiasis. Ascariasis. Echinococcosis and alveococcosis. Trichinosis. Cysticercosis).
