

## PLAN

1. General infection syndrome. Fever of unknown origin. Sepsis, septic shock. Infections associated with the provision of medical care. Diseases that occur with lymphadenopathy . HIV infection

2. Infectious diseases of the respiratory system: acute catarrhal syndrome, acute respiratory viral infections, acute pneumonia, tonsillitis syndrome. Acute respiratory failure

3. Infectious diseases that occur with damage to the hepatobiliary system and the gastrointestinal tract: acute and chronic viral hepatitis, acute liver damage of bacterial and parasitic etiology, infectious diarrhea. Abdominal revival and hypovolemic shock

4. Infectious diseases of the central nervous system: meningitis, encephalitis, myelitis , with indroma of edema-swelling of the brain, neurotoxic syndrome in infectious diseases . Acute adrenal insufficiency

5. Quarantine and especially dangerous infections.
