

Plan of classes for 4th year students of medical faculty Infectious Diseases

1. General questions of infectious diseases. Fever of unknown origin. Salmonellosis of typhoid and nontyphoid groups (Typhoid fever. Paratyphoid A and B. Salmonellosis).
2. Bacterial intestinal infections (Shigellosis. Cholera. Escherichiosis. Yersiniosis. C.difficile-associated infection).
3. Foodborne toxicoinfection. Botulism. Viral intestinal infections. Protozoal intestinal infections (Amoebiasis). Pathogenetic types of infectious diarrhea.
4. Infectious diseases occurring with a predominant lesion of the central nervous system (Meningococcal infection. Rabies). The main clinical syndromes of damage to the central nervous system. Analysis and interpretation of CSF.
5. Acute viral hepatitis (enteral and parenteral viral hepatitis).
6. Complications and outcomes of viral hepatitis (Acute and chronic liver failure. Virus-associated cirrhosis of the liver. Hepatocellular carcinoma). Leptospirosis. Brucellosis.
