Thematic plan of classis on dermatology for IV year foreign students.

1. Principles of the observation of the patient with STI (anamnesis, examination, laboratory tests). Syphilis. Epidemiology. Classification. Characteristics of the pathogen. Immunity. Clinical course of untreated syphilis. Super - reinfection. The incubation period. Ways of transmission. The clinical picture, differential diagnosis of primary syphilis.
2. Clinical picture, differential diagnosis of secondary, tertiary syphilis. Latent syphilis.
3. Congenital syphilis. The clinic of early, late congenital syphilis. Methods of laboratory diagnostics of syphilis. General principles of treatment. Specific, preventive, prophylactic, trial treatment of syphilis. Posttreatment surveillance.
4. Gonococcal infection. Etiopathogenesis. ICD X, clinical classification. Clinical manifestations in men and women. Gonorrhea of girls. Laboratory diagnostics. Treatment. Chlamydia, trichomonas, mycoplasma infection: etiology, clinical presentation, laboratory diagnosis and therapy. Reiter's disease. Etiopathogenesis, clinical manifestations, diagnosis, treatment.
5. Tropical STI: chancroid, lymphogranuloma venereum, donovanosis. Etiology, clinical presentation, laboratory diagnosis and therapy. AIDS: transmission, risk groups, clinical manifestations on the skin and mucous membranes. HIV / AIDS indicator diseases. Individual prophylactic STI.
